Call



On the evening of February 28, for their 7th packing session in as many years, twenty members of the East Cobb Civitan Club packed care-packages for Project Mail Call. For dinner Henry brought giant pizzas, Cindy brought soft drinks and her home-made salads, and Mary provided brownies. After dinner, the group packed 20 care-boxes weighing a total of 273 pounds for 284 Airmen, Marines, Sailors and Soldiers in Afghanistan, Cuba, Somalia, Syria and one undisclosed location.

During their packing session, Project Mail Call passed the milestone of 179,000 US Military personnel supported. Many packers are veterans or relatives of veterans. Henry is a Cold War Army veteran, and Dan has a relative, Adrien, who served in the Korean War in the Army. Bob served in the Coast Guard, Richard served in the Army Reserve, and Carolyn had a nephew who was a Navy Aviator that flew F-18s. Anna has three nephews currently serving in the Marines, Coast Guard and Army Special Forces. Rosemarie has a son and daughter-in-law serving in the Air Force in Turkey flying C-17s and they received a care package from Project Mail Call in 2016.












There's a lot going on this month and next, please make note:
